ASBESTOS ANNUAL LETTER OF NOTIFICATION

The Browns Valley School district has had management plans prepared for all school buildings in the district. These plans are available for your inspection Monday through Friday during regular school days and normal school hours at the District Office.

The required six month surveillances have been conducted to inspect the asbestos containing materials (ACM) for change in condition. Any changes in condition have been and will be noted on the Periodic Surveillance forms found in the Asbestos Management Plan. Also, the required three year re-inspection of asbestos containing materials has been conducted by an accredited inspector. An Operations and Management Program has been implemented by the Browns Valley School District to keep the ACM located within the building(s) in good condition.

Short-term workers (contractors who work in the district) must be provided with information regarding the asbestos in the building prior to the beginning of work.

Annual IAQ Notification Letter

The Browns Valley School District advocates a healthy school environment in which the surroundings contribute to a conducive learning environment for students and productivity for teachers and staff. All school occupants should have a sense of comfort, health, and well-being.

To help accomplish this goal, the district has taken on a task of actively managing and improving its indoor air quality (IAQ). This includes an IAQ Management Plan using guidelines provided by the MN Department of Education, and the "Tools for School" document developed by the U S EPA with the American Federation of Teachers. Association of School Business officials, Council for American Private Education, National Education Agency, National Congress of Parents and Teachers (PTA) and American Lung Association.
