## Non Directory Records Permission

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) (20 U.S.C. §1232g; 34 CFT Part 99) is a Federal law that protects the privacy of student education records.

Schools must have written permission from the parent or eligible student in order to release "non-directory" information from a student's educational record.

To comply with the FERPA regulations the SWO Youth Department is requesting permission for program staff to have access to student attendance, behavior and academic data on a need-to-know basis. All staff have signed confidentiality forms and will ensure and safeguard your child(s) information. The data will be used to provide direct services to students identified as needing mentoring and additional support. Also, the data will be used to plan for and award attendance incentives.

This permission also allows students to receive incentives and the SWO Youth Department to share student names and pictures with newspapers and other media sources to showcase the student's success.

# SWO Youth Services Fund Sponsorship Policy



The SWO Youth Activities and Service Fund will sponsor district and individual 5-18years old activities subject to three categories: Educational, Sports, School activities. Matchings funds are to be used for youth activities that promote healthy, drug & alcohol free interaction among the youth. Individuals or districts are eligible for funds within a 12-month fiscal year. Also they must be in good standing (not found ineligible for prior non-compliance of Sponsorship policy) to be considered for sponsorship funds. Youth must be in good standing in school (FERPA application attached) to be considered for sponsorship funds (council motion # \_\_\_\_\_). Each youth will have a total amount of \$1000 capped for each individual.

### **Districts- Maximum (One-time \$2,500 fundraiser match)**

**Requirements:**

- Budget, supporting documentation needed.
- Request must be turned in two weeks prior to the event.
- Must not coincide with individual request

### **Individual/Group- SWO Member Activities / 18 years and under (\$1000 maximum per fiscal year)**

**Requirements:**

- Must be SWO enrolled member, printed copy
- Supporting Documentation (event flier, hotel confirmation, registration, Etc.)
- No equipment/Apparel purchases
- FERPA application needed to process
- Must not coincide with other request from same event, receipts must be turned in within 2 weeks
- Must have fully SWO enrolled member team for tournament entry fees

### **Student Travel Policy (FERPA form)**

**Eligibility:**

- Attendance
- School work (passing classes in accordance with school policy)
- Passing classes and moving onto next grade (summer sponsorship)

The Sisseton Wahpeton Oyate has declared any persons who will be in charge of transportation/chaperone of any event taking place outside of school boundaries and are not considered a school sanctioned event, and this event is sponsored and/or paid for either partially or fully with Tribal monies, this policy will take effect.

It shall be the responsibility of the person(s) involved with the transportation/chaperone of an event to see that any students traveling meet the eligibility requirements set forth by the school in which the student is attending. The tribal leaders consider that the students' education be in the forefront of every activity in which he/she is involved with. Trips that are not considered a school sanctioned activity students will be considered absent from school and all persons involved in any event meeting these criteria have responsibility to adhere to this policy.

**\*Allowing any ineligible student to travel will result in suspension of funding**

### **SWOJOM Guidelines**

1. Senior Graduation \$400: (Must provide signed copy of Diploma).
2. Senior/Junior class trip: \$200
3. 6-12 Semester grade incentive (paid in January & June): A=\$12  
B=\$10 C=\$8 D=\$2 F=negative \$-12
4. Semester K-5 grade incentive: (paid in January & June, passing grade gift certificate).
5. Student athletic costs: ½ cost up to \$100 (parental reimbursement, with attached receipt and assistance application).
6. Drivers Education: ½ cost.
7. Laptop fee: ½ cost.
8. ACT/SAT testing fees: (copy of payment receipt).
9. Semester K-12 Attendance incentive: perfect \$50/0-3 days=\$25
10. Science Fair/History Day project Boards.
11. School supplies.
12. Tutoring.
13. BYKI- Dakotah Language online program.
14. Cultural presenters.
15. Dual Credit: ½ cost fees, @ 2 times per year.
16. Other costs, specific to school.
17. Semester honor roll A=\$25 and B=\$10\*
